

FAMILY NIGHT DESCRIPTIONS

Oct. 14 – Talk to Me: Prayer and the Rosary

- Appropriate for all ages
- Activities include making a rosary, prayer book and prayer box
- Learning about prayer types including litanies, guided meditations, memorized prayer, spontaneous prayer

Oct. 28 – All Saints Day/Day of the Dead (El Dia de los Muertos)

- Appropriate for all ages, especially grades 4-6
- Learn about those who have gone to heaven and act as role models
- Discover the rich heritage of the Hispanic celebration of the Day of the Dead (All Souls)
- Activities include making a mask, cut paper banners, ofrendas (altar) and sugar skulls

Dec. 9 – Advent/Christmas Adventure

- Appropriate for all ages, especially younger grades
- Learn about the season of Advent as we wait for the coming of Jesus and Christmas the celebration of the Birth of our Savior
- Activities include a family Advent wreath, Advent calendar, Christmas crafts and Bingo

Jan. 13 – Bible Baffles

- Especially appropriate for grades 3 – 6 but all welcome
- Learn about the Bible and how it is God’s Word for us today
- Activities include Bible Look-Up games, Bible story craft activities AND “Who Wants to Be a Bible Totin’ Millionaire Games” (with prizes, of course!)

Feb. 10 – Mardi Gras/Lent Living

- Appropriate for all ages, especially younger grades
- Learn about Mardi Gras (history, foods and activities) and how Catholics prepare for the season of Lent
- Activities include making masks, Mardi Gras/Lent trivia quiz, Lent calendar, Lent crafts

Mar. 9 – St. Patrick

- Especially appropriate for younger grades
- Everyone is Irish on St. Patrick’s Day. Learn about this special Saint and also Missionary work in the Catholic Church
- Activities include video on St. Patrick, and Shamrock crafts
